Youth Day jammed pack with activities

OAKLEY -- Rappers, dancers and skate boarders will mix with bankers, police, business people and tattoo artists at the Youth Day planned for April 26.

A full day of career workshops, beauty tips, business advice and entertainment is scheduled for the Youth Day that will be held at Freedom High School in Oakley.

The Youth Day is the newest incarnation of what was called the Youth Summit for four years. Sponsored by Supervisor Federal Glover, it allows young people from all over the county to meet each other, get advice and learn things in over 25 workshops and events that they usually don't have access to in the classroom such as the "7 steps to manhood," find out the answer to the question "What's love go to do with it?", or how to get paid for video production.

During the day, the youth will be able to see demonstrations in the martial arts, learn some dance moves, get tips in buying a car, compete in 3-on-3 basketball or conquer an inflatable obstacle course.

Young people, from 12 to 18 years of age, might even win a Nintendo Wii or other prizes by improving their chances of winning by attending the workshops.

Besides Glover's office, the cities of Antioch, Oakley and Pittsburg are helping organize the day.

Admission is free. Registration starts at 8 a.m. and the day ends at 3:00 p.m. with the awarding of the prizes. Breakfast and lunch is included.
