Four-hundred turkeys will be given to East County organizations so that they can distribute them to needy families.

The frozen gobblers will be delivered this Friday, Nov. 18 by County Supervisor Federal Glover, who represents District 5, through a partnership with the Calpine Corporation and Raley's in Pittsburg.

Volunteers and agency staff will package the big birds with other holiday foodstuffs so that pre-selected families can prepare a traditional Thanksgiving meal for themselves. The recipients will arrive later in the day to pick up their holiday food package.
