CANCELLATION OF THE HOMEOWNERS' EXEMPTION

If a Homeowners' Exemption is granted and the property later becomes ineligible for the exemption, you are responsible for notifying the Assessor of that fact immediately. Section 531.6 of the Revenue and Taxation Code provides for a penalty of 25% of the escape added for failure to notify the Assessor of the county where the property is located in a timely manner when property is no longer eligible for the exemption. As a reminder, your tax bill, or copy, mailed by November 1 each year should be accompanied by a notice concerning ineligibility for the exemption.
